

Statement on the use of cookies

These websites store files, generally called cookies, on your device in accordance with the law.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small data files that make the websites you visit to remember your actions and the settings you have made on them, so you do not need to enter this information repeatedly. Cookies do not pose a danger, but are important for protection of privacy. Cookies cannot be used to identify visitors to the site or to misuse login information.

What cookies do we use?

We use third-party cookies (such as Google Analytics for traffic analysis). These cookies are managed by third parties and we do not have access to read or write this data. More information can be found on [this page](#).

Analytics

Google Analytics is a analytic tool of Google that helps websites and applications owners to understand how visitors use websites and applications. It may use a set of cookies to collect information and report on the use of the websites without Google knowing any personally identifiable information of individual visitors. The main cookie used by Google Analytics is the __ga file.

In addition to reporting web usage statistics, Google Analytics, along with some of the advertising cookies described above, can be used to show more relevant ads across Google products (such as Google Search) and on the web.
